Sights & Sounds Studies

Purpose: To better understand how children and adults with Autism Spectrum Disorders integrate information from what they see and what they hear and how they attend to this information.

You can opt to be in one or several of the following studies examining this topic:

Studies 1 and 2: Children and Adolescents between the ages of **3-16 years of age** with an **Autism Spectrum Disorder** (including **Asperger Syndrome**)

What's involved: Watching videos for 10-20 minutes and doing some problem solving tasks

Time Commitment: **Approximately 1 hour**

Study 3: Adults with **Asperger Syndrome** between the ages of **17 – 30 years**.

What's Involved: Making judgments about videos, problem-solving tasks, questions about your thoughts, feelings and behaviors.

Time Commitment: **Approximately 2 hours**

Study 4: Children and Adults between the ages of **8-40 years** with **High Functioning Autism or Asperger Syndrome**.

What's Involved: Watching videos while in an fMRI for 30 minutes, then playing some games and answering some questions about yourself.

Time Commitment: **Approximately 2 hours**

Diagnostic Process Study

Purpose: To better understand **the diagnostic process** families and individuals with ASD experience

Looking for: **Parents** of individuals diagnosed with an **Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)** or **individuals** diagnosed with an **ASD**

What's Involved: Completing an **on-line** questionnaire

Time Commitment: **Approximately 20 minutes**
